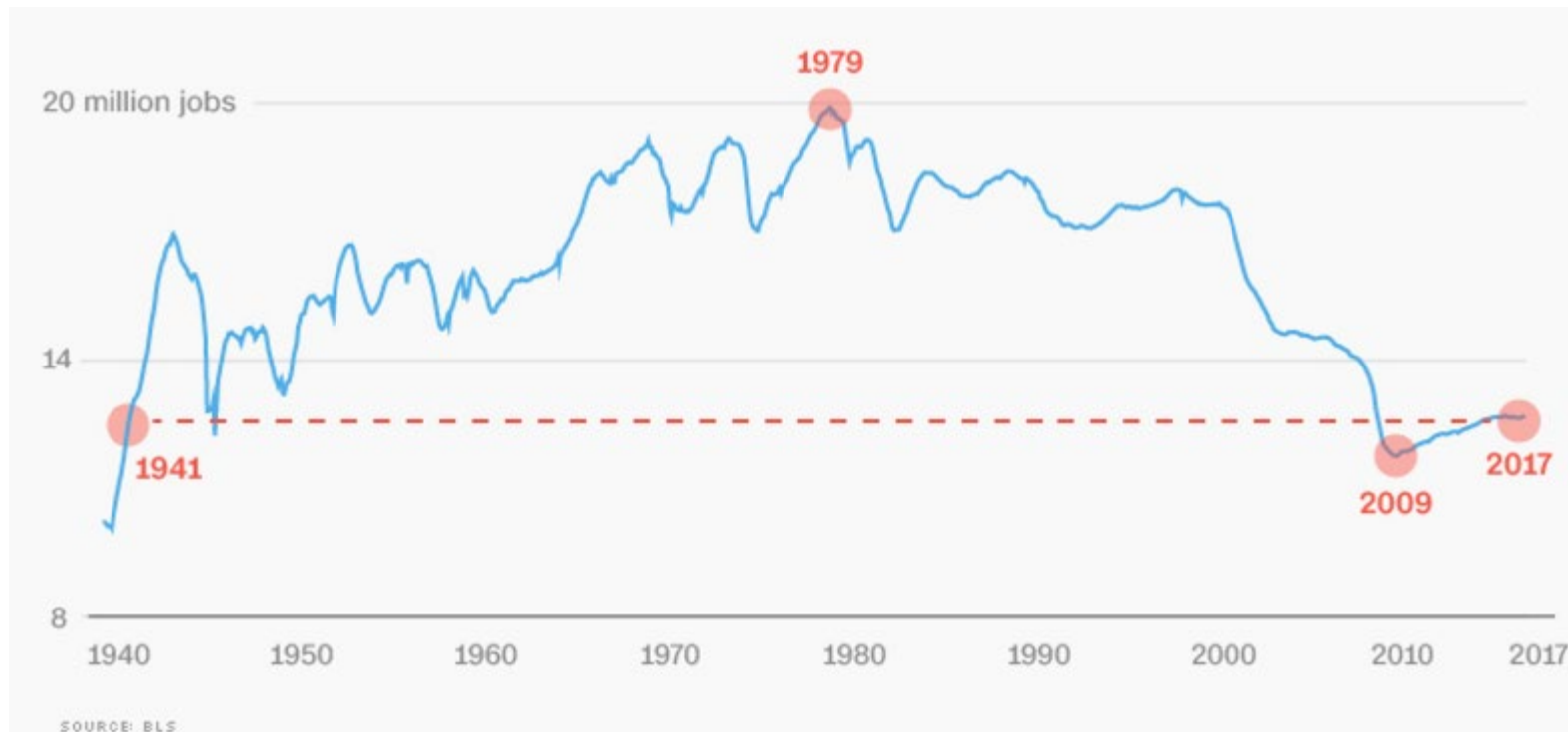




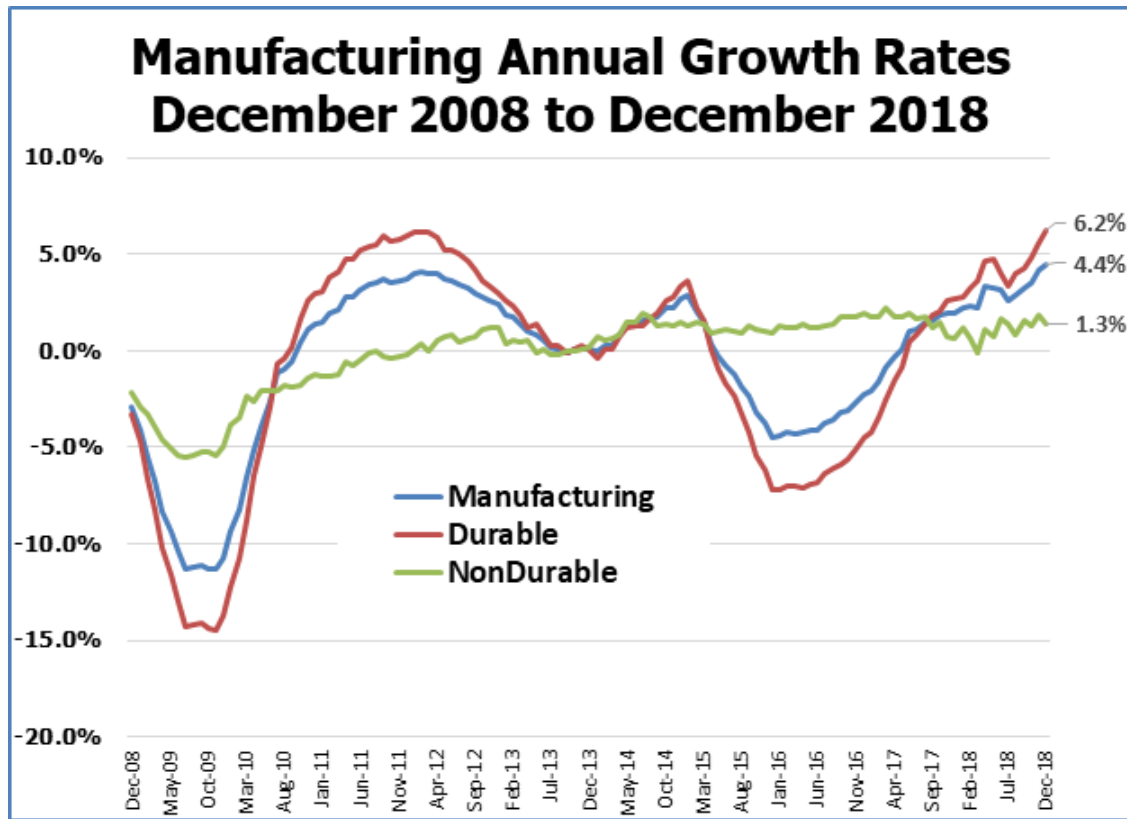




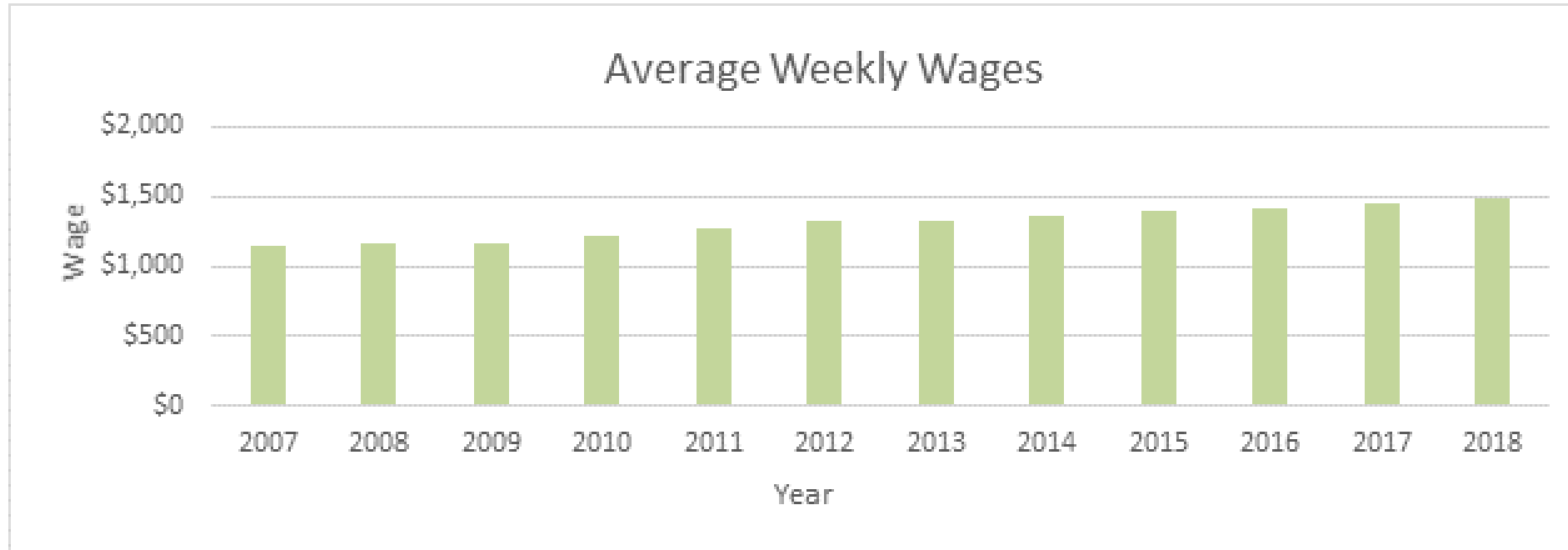
# U.S. Manufacturing Jobs

  - 30% since 2007



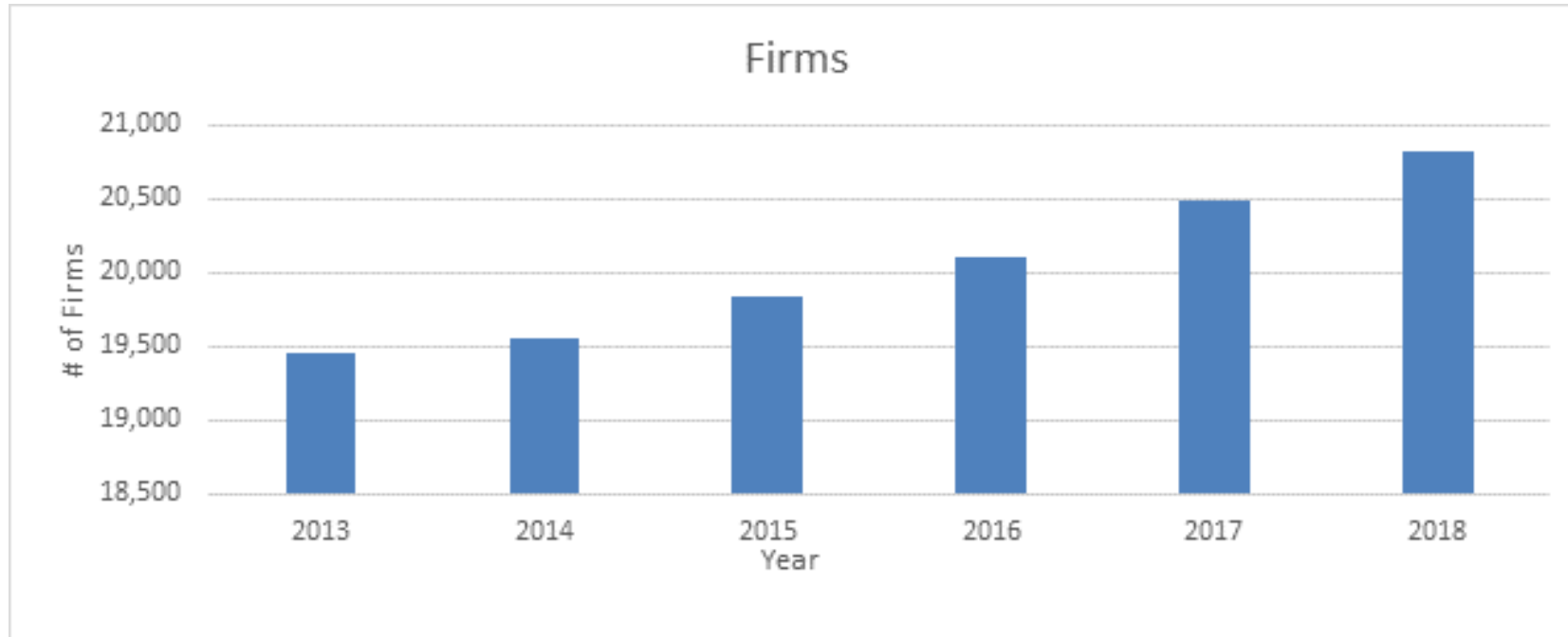
# Total Wages
