- 1993 Wiring Harness Manufacturing Association is formed
- 1996 3 random calls in one week to IPC asking for Harness workmanship standard. IPC Committee launched. 3 months after launch and article in Wiring Harness News indicates WHMA standards committee formed. Collaboration proposed and accepted
- 620 Initial publication 2000. Rev A 2006, Rev B 2012 Rev C 2017 Rev D 2020 Space Addendum published 2011
- Certification program launched in 2002
- IPC/WHMA affiliation 2019
